## 2021 quick updates

#### Croatia

After a COVID driven 5.4% decline in 2020, Croatia recovered more than fully in 2021 by an increase in cement consumption of close to 8%. At the same time, imports also increased by more than 160,000 tonnes whereas exports increased by close to 150,000. This has led in an increased cement production of 3.5% in 2021. Per capita in 2021 was the highest it has been in the last ten years.

#### **Netherlands**

Following a small decline in 2002 due to COVID, cement consumption grew in 2021 by around 4%. This has resulted in overall demand reaching a decade high in the year. All cement in the Netherlands is either imported or produced by grinding plants. The last integrated plant having been closed in 2019. Around 75% of domestic cement consumption was satisfied by imports in 2021, the rest being produced by the indigenous grinding plants.

#### Slovakia

2021 was another year of cement consumption decline. Following the close to 14% decline in 2020, Slovakia did not manage to recover in 2021, but registered a small drop of demand of around 2%. As a result, 2021 was close to 16% lower than the decade high consumption year of 2019. Production dropped by around 1% in 2021, whereas imports increased by 15% and exports by close to 3%.


#### Slovenia

2021 was the seventh year of uninterrupted domestic cement consumption growth. Cement consumption in 2021 registered a 6% growth over 2020 and stood a full 80% higher than the decade low of 2014. Imports rose in 2021 by twice as much as exports reaching close to 550,000 tonnes. as a result, production only increased by 4% in 2021. Utilisation rates in this one-plant market rose to over 73%.






## 2021 Updates - Key macroeconomic and cement related figures






## 2021 Updates – Key cement related figures (production, domestic growth, and trading)
